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V. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Rockslide on CR 29 occurred during the winter 2018. The Routt County Road & Bridge Assistant Director contacted GSI, Yenter & Co. and Midwest Rockfall, Inc. GSI met onsite May 21, 2018 and provided an estimate June 3, 2018. Yenter & Co. no longer provide this service, and Midwest did not respond.

Contracting Services for Rock Mitigation are put out to bid by CDOT, and GSI is currently under contract with CDOT. GSI has provided an updated quote on July 22, 2019 and the timeline to complete this project in 2019.

We are requesting a Waiver of the formal purchasing project due to the limited pool of Colorado contractors providing this service and in the best interest of the County to have the remaining rockfall mitigation completed for the safety of the community traveling on CR29.
