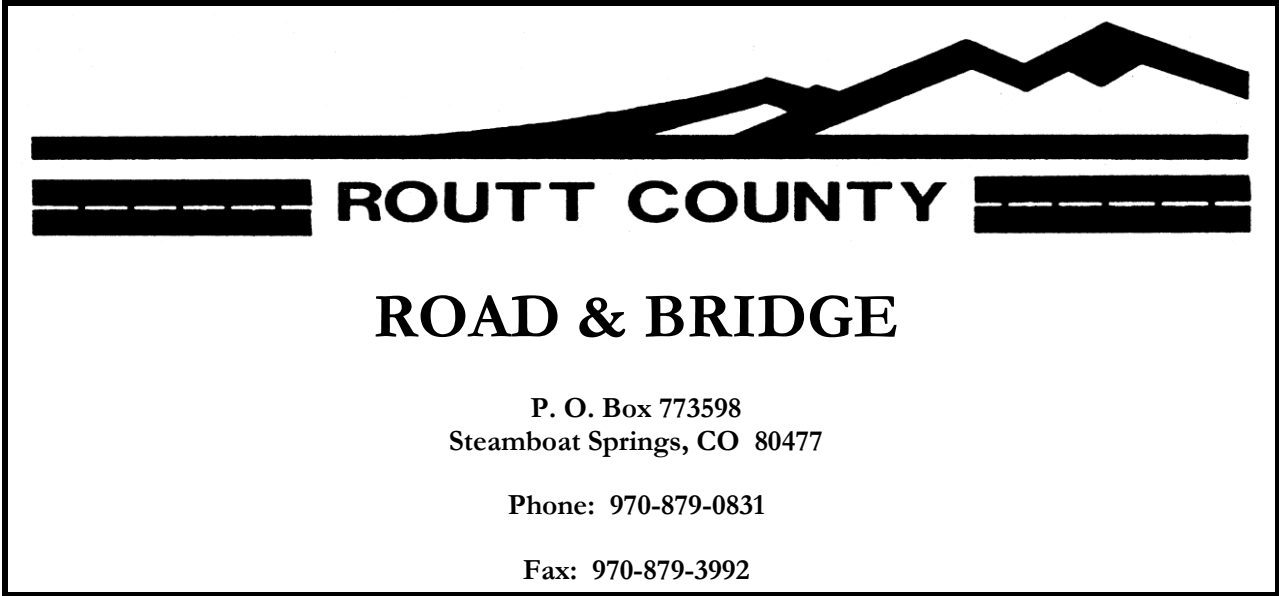

Guidelines for Winter Maintenance within the County / Public Road Right of Way

I _____ agree to comply with the following guidelines:

1. Remove snow of the entire width of the traveled County Road, including sufficient turnouts and turnarounds for safe and efficient travel of the public
2. Leave culvert inlets in a natural condition without snow or other material plowed into them so that the drainage system will function normally.
3. Sanding of driving surfaces, i.e. corners and hills, shall be provided, as needed for safe and efficient travel of the public.
4. Equipment utilized must adequate for plowing operations and in proper working condition.
5. All debris, including snow and ice, that is removed from the road surface and ditches shall be deposited away from stream channels at agreed upon locations. Ditches and culverts shall be kept functional during and upon completion of snow plowing operations.
6. Gravel surfacing material shall not be bladed off the road. Roads shall not be plowed in the fall or springs when surface is not frozen.
7. No Snow shall be plowed into the public road or across the road and dumped in adjacent property. Permittee shall push the windrow beyond the edge of the road so that the drainage from the snow berm feeds into the ditch or off the traveled surface of the road. Do not block hydrants.
8. Sanding operations must use Sanding Material approved by Routt County Road & Bridge prior to application.
9. Applicant shall provide all needed plowing. County crews cannot be relied upon to provide any support.
10. The County may impose other requirements and restrictions or revoke this permit at its discretion.
11. No road maintenance work shall be performed without written authorization bearing the signature of a Routt County Road & Bridge representative.
