



**A & D. MOONHILL SCHOOLHOUSE**  
**County Road 129, Clark**

The Moonhill Schoolhouse was established in 1913 as a one-room school, grades kindergarten through eighth grade, for District 10, and served in that capacity until the early 1950s. From then until 1989 the RE-2 District owned the building, which served as a community gathering place for parties, pot-luck dinners, church services, a polling location, dances, and other functions. In 1989, the Schoolhouse was purchased by the North Routt Fire Protection District, which intended to make it a year-round community center. To that end, a non-profit organization was formed to raise funds to renovate the building's wiring, install a new furnace and second exit, and refurbish the siding and interior. After the renovations were completed, the building was used as a short-term pre-school daycare center as well as for community activities.
